From the north take US 53 south to County S (Jim Falls) exit and follow S to the east. From the east take highway 29 west to highway 27 in Cadott and then north to S, then west on S.

From the west take highway 29 east to highway 27 in Cadott and then north to S, then west on S.

From the south you can take highway 27 north or US 53 to County S and then follow the above directions.
