For requirement #4 - Interview an older relative in person, by phone or by letter. Scouts can bring a tape of the interview or the questions asked and answers written out. The purpose is to find out about the life of that person and important dates in their life (birth, death, marriage, names of parents and/or siblings etc.)  
For requirement #5- A copy of a genealogical document. This can be a birth, death, marriage certificate, a family Bible with a family tree, baptismal certificate, a picture of a family gravestone.
