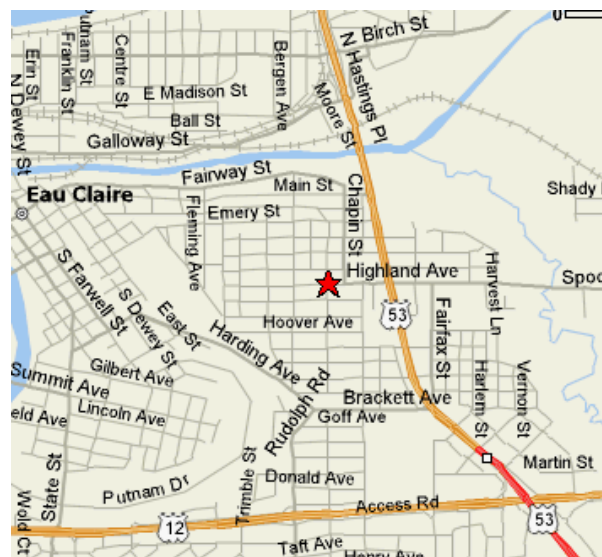
Life-to-Eagle Training for Scouts and Parents
