



Eagle Scout **David Arneberg**, son of Tom & Beth Arneberg, is a senior at “Chi-Hi,” Chippewa Falls High School, where he was recently named one of the three valedictorians of the Class of 2014. David has led the troop as Senior Patrol Leader, Patrol Leader, Instructor, Bugler, and Scribe in his six years as a Scout. He holds the troop record for the most high-adventure trips taken: two trips to Northern Tier in the BWCA (55 and 75 miles canoeing and portaging), two trips to Philmont (65 miles backpacking with the troop and an amazing 180 miles with Rayado), and a hundred-mile canoe trip in Northern Wisconsin. He served as Crew Leader for the Northern Tier and HUMICAT trips. David was elected to the Order of the Arrow, and spent a week at National Youth Leader Training. For his Eagle project, he led a team in building a play-set for a Habitat for Humanity house. He played trombone for the marching band and is also active in sports, serving as captain of the tennis and soccer teams, and earning second-team all-conference in both sports. David has competed at the state level in tennis, Science Olympiad, and Skills USA, and at the national level in DECA and Construction Challenge. Following graduation this June, he will enter the U.S. Air Force Academy in Colorado to major in Mechanical Engineering.
