He is expecting over 100 Scouts from many area troops. We'll be camping at the Cadott Country Fest campgrounds (featuring hot showers!), and we'll take a day trip to the river Saturday with canoes. Each troop or patrol will be assigned a section of the river to clean up. This counts for service hours for both rank advancement and for conservation awards. We'll be cooking by patrols as normal, except that Saturday's lunch will be eaten while we're working on the river.
