Details: After our highly successful DURABIT, several Scouts were asking about some day doing a self-contained trip, where we carry all our camping gear on our bikes. So this is our first-ever bike trip to test out this concept. The easiest way to haul gear on your bikes is to use panniers with a rear rack.

We'll be riding 25 miles each way, hauling our sleeping bags, tents or hammocks, clothes, mess kits, etc. on our bikes. We shouldn't need to haul much food, since we can buy groceries in Cornell before we get to our campsite at Brunet Island State Park. Note that **helmets are mandatory (along with Troop72 red "action" shirts)**. The fee should cover all the food for Sunday supper and Monday breakfast, but **bring extra money** if you want to buy anything at the halfway point at the Jim Falls Cenex, or if you want to get ice cream in Cornell.
